Message From The President

I am delighted to welcome you to the 30th Anniversary celebration of JHFCAA Canada. The committee is heartened by the enthusiasm of the alumni and their friends who have joined us to celebrate this milestone.

We are proud to celebrate 30 years of the JHFCAA, founded in 1989 by Mrs.

Theresa Alexander (who sends her regrets today) and other pioneer ladies who had the vision to continue the culture and values of our Alma Mater here in Canada. The diligent efforts of the alumni continue to support our objectives year over year, and the enriching fellowship reflects our pride in continuing this tradition.

Since 1989, we have grown and strengthened our reach each year, and this has been made possible by the dedication of our members and volunteers. Tonight is also a recognition of all those who have selflessly contributed their time and resources to the JHFCAA over the past three decades. A special thanks to the 2018-20 committee of very talented women who have worked hard for the past few months to make this night possible. We are also very fortunate to have many sponsors who have continually supported us over the years and I sincerely thank them on behalf of the committee

Our close collaboration with our alma mater continues; to date the 2018-20 committee has donated, with your support, \$10,000 for various school projects. We will also be adding a further \$10,000 (from the proceeds of this Gala) to the Perpetual Fund, established by the prior committee, which aids the long-term academic needs of the JHFC. The income from the principal (\$20,500 in total) will fund student scholarships for years to come.

We are extremely proud to announce that students from JHFC have won first place in the province wide English poetry and drama competitions and have been selected to participate at the National level. In addition, 23 grade five students have been selected for scholarships among the 115 who passed the exam. 95 of those 115 students scored 100 marks on the exam. The principal sent a heartfelt message thanking JHFCAA Canada for supporting this initiative. In the spring of this year, we were informed that 80% of the students who sat for the AL exam in 2018 got through to University in all three streams.

Michelle Obama said, "when you've worked hard, and done well, and walked through that doorway of opportunity...you do not slam it shut behind you...you reach back, and you give other folks the same chances that helped you succeed."

This sentiment embodies the main values that have always been at the heart of this Alumni Association, inspiring the activity of committee members, past and present and most certainly in the future. The "give back" principle, that mutual sharing of "something" that we ourselves have previously received from the community. We are all here today to celebrate their success.

We also aim to ensure that the JHFCAA becomes increasingly a point of reference for all Alumni Associations and that the value of the JHFC brand is further strengthened, here and internationally.





My husband Michael and I send our congratulations to the Members and Friends of the Jaffna Holy Family Convent Alumni Association Canada while celebrating thirty years of cohesiveness in helping our Alma Mater in Jaffna to evolve under testing times as well as halcyon days. We applaud those who started this Alumni Association of Jaffna Holy Family



Convent in Canada thirty years ago in 1989, and all those who have been tirelessly striving to keep the association vibrant and innovative.

Our old school was started in 1845 by Mrs. Flannagan to teach English language to Jaffna girls. In 1862, the Holy Family nuns took over Mrs. Flannagan's English school for girls and established the first Holy Family Convent "English school" in Sri Lanka. A sister school was started later to teach in Tamil language by the Holy Family Nuns adjacent to the English School. Boys were also admitted to study from kindergarten to third grade while the English School functioned as a Collegiate Private School. The Jaffna Holy Family Convent Tamil School was taken over by the Government in 1961 and became Holy Family Convent Maha-Vidyalayam. Later, the Holy Family Convent Collegiate Private School that had grades up to 12, which prepared students to enter university was amalgamated with the Holy Family Convent Maha-Vidyalayam in 2002 and became a government school. The joined school was recognized as national school in 2010 by the government and named J/Holy Family Convent National School. We have indeed evolved and continued to excel even under adversity, especially during the times of two and a half decades of horrible war.

Our past students and teachers, who had very close association with the Holy Family Convent Collegiate Private School, started the JHFC AA Canada in 1989 prior to the amalgamation with the Holy family Convent Maha-Vidyalayam. Even though the Private School became a government-run school, they continue to support the National School with passion and true Familian spirit. Our sincere gratitude to the current & past committee members and all the members of the Jaffna Holy Family Convent Alumni Association of Canada for their devotion to our Alma Mater.





